Recent reports in *The Financial Review* have indicated that two staffers to Wayne Swan Treasurer received large termination payouts and have subsequently returned to other Government roles, including one staffer returning to work for the Treasurer after 6 months. Without providing names of individuals involved, can you provide details of payments made to Ministerial staffers who have taken severance payments and then returned to work for the same Minister? Please include the amounts paid in each instance and the period of time before subsequent employment, as well as any clawback arrangements put in place?

Answer:

The number of Ministerial personal staff terminated under the *Members of Parliament (Staff) Act 1984* due to the swearing in of the new Ministry on 14 September 2010 and subsequently re-employed by the same Minister or Parliamentary Secretary, either as personal or electorate staff, is two. Details are as follows:
