Senator Humphries (L&C 77-78) asked:

In the course of negotiations dealing with the passengers on the Oceanic Viking were there any discussions between the Australian and Indonesian governments that brought in the status of the 255 or so Tamils on the boat that is moored at Merak?

Answer.

The Government has made it clear to Indonesia that the *Oceanic Viking* and Merak cases are distinct and should be treated as such.

The details of discussions between governments should appropriately remain confidential between these governments.
