¹ It should be noted that some people hold more than one position on one or more boards. The tables set out the number of appointees and their gender, rather than the number of people, per board. 'Board' is defined as the membership of a statutory or non-statutory body in the Attorney-General's portfolio to which appointments are made by the Government.

² Of these members, Justice Garry Downes AM is an ex-officio member on the Council, due to his appointment as President of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal. Professor Rosalind Croucher is an ex-officio member by virtue of her appointment as President of the Australian Law Reform Commission.

³ The membership of the Australian Crime Commission (ACC) is comprised of 15 ACC Board members and four ACC Examiners. All ACC Board members are ex officio. This consists of seven Commonwealth representatives, and eight State and Territory Police Commissioners (including the ACT Chief Police Officer). The Commonwealth does not exercise any control over State and Territory representatives. ACC Examiners are appointed as statutory office holders.
