Senator Trood asked the following question at the hearing on 25 May 2011:

What explanation did the Office of National Assessments provide to ASIO as to why they were unable to proceed with their tenancy in the new ASIO building.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

On 25 June 2008 the Office of National Assessment (ONA) provided ASIO the following reasons as to why ONA would no longer be proceeding with plans to be a sub-tenant in the ASIO new building:

- ONA had a critical space shortfall in their present location and required a more immediate solution.
 - The ASIO new building is scheduled for completion in late 2012.
 - ONA were exploring options with partner Agencies to be located in the same precinct.
- Funding pressures associated with the proposed new building indicated that an alternative solution would be more cost effective for ONA and the Commonwealth.
 - By withdrawing from the new building, ONA would not need to proceed with disruptive interim works to optimise current accommodation.
