Senator Siewert asked the following question at the hearing on 24 May 2012:

What will be the impact of the budget decision to divert \$60 million over four years from the Confiscated Assets Account to consolidated revenue on the future funding and provision of community crime prevention and drug and alcohol diversionary programs?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

This savings measure is being used to offset expenditure in other areas of the portfolio. This will help fund the Stronger Futures package.

The Stronger Futures package is a \$239 million project to increase community safety in Indigenous communities in the Northern Territory. The Attorney Generals' Department funds about half of this. The package includes things like:

- providing more family violence and child-protection facilities and services;
- tackling alcohol abuse across Australia;
- protecting remote Indigenous communities with more police; and
- supporting night patrols in communities.
