## Answer.

DIAC measures the success of its Access and Equity goals under the four principles and performance indicators as outlined in the Commonwealth Government's Access and Equity Framework:

- Responsiveness the extent to which programmes and services are accessible, fair and responsive to the individual needs of clients,
- Communication open and effective channels of communication with all stakeholders,
- Accountability effective and transparent reporting and review mechanisms,
- Leadership A whole of government approach to the management of issues arising from Australia's culturally and linguistically diverse society.
