Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 64) asked:

How many of those Vietnamese unaccompanied minors under the age of 11 in the Darwin facility have been told that they have failed their protection applications.

Answer.

Of the five Vietnamese minors under the age of 11 in the Darwin facility as at 21 May 2012:

- Four had been found not to be a refugee at the primary stage and were awaiting a review decision
- One had been found not to be a refugee at the primary and review stage.
