Senator Hanson-Young asked:

What classification of Departmental staff can access or see adverse security assessments? Are there any limits on who can see the assessments? Do case managers see the assessments?

Answer.

Adverse security assessments, like all classified documents, require a Departmental officer to hold a security clearance relevant to the classification of the document. In addition, the officer must have a genuine 'need to know', to view the content of any classified document.

Generally, case managers do not view the content of an adverse assessment.
