Question No. 7

Senator Humphries asked the following question at the hearing on 18 October 2010:

In the last financial year, 714 films were classified in the X category. How does that figure compare approximately with five years ago (no exact figure required)? Please also provide a figure for the past ten years of the number of films classified in that category and the number of films submitted for classification.

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

In 2009-2010, 714 commercial films were classified X 18+. This is lower than five years ago.

7,110 commercial films were classified X 18+ in the past ten years (ie, from the beginning of financial year 2000-2001 to the end of financial year 2009-2010).

A total of 46,851 commercial films were submitted for classification in the same ten year period.
