Senator Brandis asked the following question at the hearing on 16 October 2012:

On 9 August 2012, the Government announced that it will shortly advertise for the appointment of the next Commonwealth Director of Public Prosecutions.

- 1. How many applicants responded to the advertisement?
- 2. What is the progress on this matter?
- 3. When is the vacancy expected to be filled?

The answer to the honourable senator's question is as follows:

- 1. Twenty-three expressions of interest were received. Nine applications were made.
- 2. The selection panel has provided its report to the Attorney-General. The Attorney- General's proposed nominee is undergoing a security clearance process.
- 3. The position will be filled once the Governor-General has approved the appointment of a new Director of Public Prosecutions.
