(SE12/0208) PROGRAM – 1.1: Visa and Migration

Senator Hanson-Young (L&CA 47) asked:

For 2011-12, provide the number of visitor visa applications, the grant rates and the rejection rates for citizens from Afghanistan, Burma, Burundi, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Iraq, Iran, Rwanda, Somalia, Sri Lanka and Sudan.

Answer:

The requested Visitor visa data is provided in the table below. Visitor visas available to the specified nationalities include the Tourist (Subclass 676) visa, the Sponsored Family Visitor (Subclass 679) visa and the Business (Short Stay) (Subclass 456) visa.

The grant rate is the number of grants expressed as a percentage of the total number of decisions (grants plus refusals) for the same period. The rejection (or refusal) rate is the inverse of the grant rate.

The number of grants and refusals is not necessarily equal to the number of applications in the same period because some applications may be finalised in a later period.
