Cambelltown Police station 2 July 1948 for Sexual Assault, I applied for my file Opera Home in 1947, when I read the lies Mrs Gordon wrote, all because he couldn't have sex with me, I believe with his report of me has followed me all my life, I believe I was judge by that report of me when I went for help with my three boys at Wellave when I was being advolced from my house, I should say no help, anything that I did before I went to that home - I did not deserve to be treated

how Mrs Gordon treated, he terrorised me from James day until he left he would put me and I seelashon for 24 hours and 48 hour, he could come in the cells anytime day or night as he lived on the front of the home, he would come in bash you anytime he felt like it. I would like to be heard, I have never been to since since him. I have never been able to trust anyone since him. I have been in prison every since Parramatta kids home, I have only gone out of the house in the last 3 to 4 years. I would really like someone to listen to how Mrs Gordon effected my life and my family that suffered with how I have been in. All I know is I thank God for the loving and caring parents I had as a child and after coming home from that hell hole. It was lucky some of the children he was interested with I wouldn't have be as lucky as me. I hope you will hear my story about Mrs Gordon.
