My name is Rhonda Griechen I was born in 1952. I was in the Church of England girls home in Carlingford NSW from around 1958 to 1965. I was around four when I went in.. My name then was Rhonda Bauer.

I never talked about it, it was so horrible that I just tried to shut it out, but it never goes away. I was beaten, and had emotional deprivation and torture.

I was sexually abused.

I was lent out to Christians for holidays, people that had no police clearance and got to take little girls home for the holidays.

I only went back two years ago with my father to try and put demons to rest. I had too, before my father died, he had no idea what was going on he thought he was doing the right thing. I was too terrified as a child to tell him, and we were threatened to keep our mouths shut. I only just told him and he was horrified, and he died two years later so I only got those two years to get to know my father and forgive him. I always blamed him for what happened to me.

I am glad it's all coming out in the open.
I feel like I have a chance now to tell my story

Thank you from the bottom of my heart for exposing this to the Australian public. For years we were the forgotten children, I used to think god was the boogieman who sent these people to torment children in his name.
