SUBMISSION TO THE PARLIAMENTARY JOINT COMMITTEE ON CORPORATIONS & FINANCIAL SERVICES

SUMMARY:

We had been clients of Storm Financial for 10 years. As we had no knowledge of the share market, we placed our trust in them to manage our investment and take us into a comfortable retirement.

We were always assured that their strong research gave them "the edge" over other financial planning firms, therefore they were in the best position to manage our affairs.
