Our Submission:

We the undersigned Management Committee members of the Cherbourg Historical Precinct Group together with community members of Cherbourg whose paid labour was controlled by government hereby state that we were victims of the Stolen Wages era and believe that the monies paid to date by government is no where near what is owing.

People from that era of living and working "Under the Act" have not received award wages, holiday pays, long service leave, compensation, superannuation etc or any other work entitlements.

Also during this period aboriginal people were also deprived of a lot of benefits and entitlements such as pensions, child endowment, maternity allowance, sickness benefit etc. The government need to compensate a lump sum payment to those who have suffered physically, socially and financially and who still experience the intergenerational effects today.

We believe as an Aboriginal Nation that Reconciliation with the Government will not eventuate until justice or some form of proper compensation be paid to those who were born, lived and worked under the Aboriginal Protection Acts from 1897, 1939 through to 1965.
