Polypropylene resins are manufactured at two sites, Geelong, Victoria; and Clyde, New South Wales; which obtain propylene and ethylene gas feedstock from local refineries and petrochemical plants.

A joint venture of Basell Australia, PolyPacific Pty Ltd, located in Dandenong, Victoria, produces, markets and sells polypropylene compounds used in specialised applications such as automotive bumpers.

Basell Australia employs approximately 175 people, including chemical process operators, engineers, laboratory staff, instrument/ electrical tradespeople, finance management and support, logistics and sales personnel and others.
