Agreement between the Government of Australia and the Government of the French Republic Regarding Defence Cooperation and Status of Forces Hearing 15 September 2008

Question 1 Defence cooperation agreements with other countries Mr Thomson, Proof Hansard, 15 September 2008, p.16

a) How many defence cooperation agreements with other countries do we have?

RESPONSE

Australia has four defence cooperation agreements with other countries. They are:

- An Exchange of Notes constituting an Agreement with the Government of the United States of America concerning Certain Mutual Defence Commitments (Chapeau Defence Agreement) [1995] ATS 35;
- A framework Agreement with the Government of the Republic of Turkey on Cooperation in Military Fields [2006] ATNIF 15;
- An agreement between Australia and the Republic of Indonesia on the Framework for Security Cooperation [2006] ATNIF 25; and
- An agreement with the United Arab Emirates on Defence Cooperation [2007] ATNIF 10.

Question 2 ADF visits to France Mr Thomson, Proof Hansard, 15 September 2008, p.16

a) How many Australian Defence Force (ADF) personnel regularly visit France?

RESPONSE

There were 291 Defence sponsored visitors to France in 2007 and 269 in 2006. These numbers reflect all Australian Defence visitors, including Australian Defence Force personnel, Defence public servants and Defence contractors.

Question 3 Status of Forces Agreements <u>Mr Simpkins, Proof Hansard, 15 September 2008, p.17</u>

a) Is there any difference between this Status of Forces Agreement (SoFA) and other ones that have been signed with other countries?

RESPONSE

There is no substantive difference between the Australia–France SoFA and SoFA's we have with other countries.
