Thank you for your letter of 24 October 2003 concerning the treaties being reviewed by the Joint Standing Committee on Treaties (JSCOT) that were tabled in Parliament on 8 October 2003. The Queensland Government supports legally binding action being taken on these treaties.

The International Labour Organisation Convention No. 182: Convention concerning the Prohibition and Immediate Action for the Elimination of the Worst Forms of Child Labour was considered by the Queensland Cabinet in November 2002. The Queensland Government maintains that Queensland's legislation is sufficient to achieve compliance with the articles of this convention.

The Queensland Government, through its Commission for Children and Young People, is presently conducting a review of child labour with the aim of ensuring that the rights, interests and wellbeing of children under 18 years are protected in paid, and unpaid, employment. This current review demonstrates the ongoing commitment of the Queensland Government to ensure the most effective systems are in place for the protection of children and young people.

Article 7-2 (e) of the Convention refers to the need to take account of the special situation of girls regarding education. The Queensland Government notes a report published by the Australian Council for Educational Research, School Leavers in Australia: Profiles and Pathways Research Report Number 31, which provides evidence that boys are generally underachieving within the education setting and leaving school at a more significant rate than girls. It is recommended that this issue not be overlooked.
