Sara.

The following are my responses to the qusetions I took on notice during the hearing of the Joint Standing Committee held on Norfolk Island.

1) Current costs of a new anaesthetic machine is \$65,000

2) We have had everal pieces of equipment that have broken down requiring emergency replacement. These include Diathermy machines that broke down during an operating theatre case, the mobile x-ray unit and the standing X-ray Bucky, Blood Red Cell Washer and the Biochemistry Analyser.

3) It is very difficult to provide an accurate breakdown of the \$15,000,000 suggested for the provision of a new hospital or Multi Purpose Centre. However, as far as I can estimate it could be between \$10,000,000 and \$15,000,000. The following would be required:

In these estimates I have included equipment requirements.

\$350,000 Acquisition of land Operating Theatre
