The following table provides the requested data relating to total loans, loans in default, loans written off and losses for large business loans for the last five years. These data are based on material extracted from the database used for Pillar 3 reporting to APRA in respect of credit exposures which includes lending and other credit risk exposures.

Commonwealth Bank classified 'large business' with reference to the following Basel III Pillar 3 asset classes: Corporate, Corporate and Specialised Lending. It does not include bank and sovereign lending.
