## **Question:**

Dr MULINO: I just had a couple of very quick questions on the heatmap. Are you able to provide information on how many times the heat map has been accessed, and, if possible, a bit of a breakdown as to how many times by individuals and how times many by organisations?

Mrs Rowell: We'd have to take that on notice. I certainly don't have that information to hand, but I'm happy to look and see what information we could provide.

## Answer:

The MySuper Product Heatmap was published on the APRA website on 10 December 2019.

The numbers below cover the period between 10 December 2019 and 5 August 2020.

We are unable to ascertain the breakdown by individual or organisation.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Page views record all visits to the page, including when a user reloads the page or returns to the page multiple times.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Unique page views aggregate page views that are generated by a single user. For example, if one user visits the page six times, it is recorded as six page views but only one unique page view.
