Question:

In regards to the operational sites used by ASIC:

- (a) Are there any additional operational sites used by ASIC not listed on the website? If so where are these sites located?
- (b) Which sites are leased and which are owned by ASIC?
 - (i) Of those sites that are leased, do these leases include upkeep and renovation costs?

Answer:

- a) ASIC has two sites that are not listed on our Web Site. These are in the Latrobe Valley in Victoria.
- b) ASIC does not own any property. All operational sites are leased.
 - i) In all ASIC leased sites, except for the Traralgon Office, the building owner is responsible for the maintenance and renovation of the base building and ASIC is responsible for the interior fitout. The Traralgon Office is occupied under Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Australian Tax Office (ATO). The MoU with the ATO is for a fixed amount each year and includes all maintenance except for minor items such as light bulb changes. Liability for the cost associated with the upkeep of the site sits with the ATO. There are no renovations planned that require funding.
