Energy Super has historically held an annual Golf Day, at golf clubs throughout South East Queensland. The Golf Days have been held in each of the years 2015 – 2018.

The invitees are our participating employer groups, sponsoring organisations (employer associations and unions) and business partners / service providers.

The event is primarily a way to say thank you to these groups for their support throughout the year, in addition to being a business development opportunity.

The event is fully funded through the sale of sponsorship packages to businesses wishing to have exposure to the Fund's employers and stakeholders. As a result, none of the costs have been paid for from the Fund.

Following a review of Energy Super's marketing programme this year, we decided to not run one in 2019 and do not propose to hold Golf Days going forward.
