### Section 3(d)

Please list the steps you have taken to assure yourself you have not acquired citizenship of another country by descent, marriage or other means.

Even assuming that my grandmother was a British citizen, prior to 1983, a person could inherit British citizenship only from his or her father (see subsection 1(1)(b) of the British Nationality and Status of Aliens Act 1914, and section 5 of the British Nationality Act 1948). My father therefore cannot have inherited British citizenship from my grandmother, which means that any such citizenship cannot have passed to me, either.

Further, under the 1948 Act, the general rule was that no person born between 1949 and 1983 could become a British citizen by descent from a parent who was himself a citizen by descent only (see section 5). The limited exceptions to that rule are not relevant to me. Therefore, even assuming my father was somehow a British citizen by descent, I cannot myself have inherited that citizenship.

I have also consulted with the Embassy of Ireland in Australia – see attached letter.

Dear Mr. Gee

Thank you for your letter of 22 November 2017 concerning Irish citizenship.

In order for an individual to become an Irish citizen by descent they are required under the Irish Nationality and Citizenship Act 1956 - 2011 to apply for entry into the Foreign Births Register. You have confirmed that you have never sought to have your birth registered in the Foreign Births Register and that no such application has been made on your behalf.

Where such applications were not made for an individual born outside Ireland to parents who were also born outside Ireland, citizenship by descent could not have been granted to that individual.

I hope that this clarifies matters for you.
