

According to Article 9 of the Nationality Law of the People's Republic of China: Any Chinese national who has settled abroad and who has been naturalised as a foreign national or has acquired foreign nationality of their own free will shall automatically lose Chinese nationality. I was naturalised as an Australian citizen on 9 April 1992, and therefore lost my Chinese nationality on this date.

I obtained a Declaration of Change of Nationality from the Hong Kong Immigration Department which confirms my change of nationality was registered with effect from 20 September 2018. (attached).
