Please list the steps you have taken to assure yourself you have not acquired citizenship of another country by descent, marriage or other means.

My husband was born in Italy but lost Italian citizenship in 1958 when he was naturalised as an Australian. Out of an abundance of caution, I have sought legal advice to confirm my citizenship status through marriage. I do not intend to, and do not, waive any privilege in it. However, I remain assured that I am not an Italian citizen through marriage.

Regarding Italian citizenship by descent, the High Court recognised in Re Canavan that I would have had to register to become a citizen. I have never applied to register for Italian citizenship.

Regarding US citizenship, according to the US Citizenship and Immigration Service website, a child born outside the United States before 14 November 1980 could only be a US citizen where both of their parents were US citizens at the time of birth.

The website of the Swedish Embassy in Canberra makes it clear that Swedish law prior to 200 f did not recognise dual citizenship, with the result that when my grandfather was naturalised as an Australian in 1914, his one-year-old daughter lost any Swedish citizenship she may have had. That being the case, I cannot have inherited Swedish citizenship from my mother.

A document detailing the date of Australian naturalisation is attached.

Old Swedish citizenship law-1894

According to paragraph 5 of the 1894 Swedish citizen's rights law, a person who becomes a citizen of another country will lose the right of citizenship in Sweden.

Paragraph 7 of the same law also states that a Swedish male, who has reached the age of 21 years and has been continuously living in another country for 10 years, loses his right of Swedish citizenship. The loss of citizenship also applies to his wife and underaged children.

The Swedish citizenship is derived from a parent. Previous generations possible Swedish citizenship or right of citizenship cannot lead to Swedish citizenship for later generations.

If the ancestor lost their Swedish citizenship after 1 January 1905, later generations cannot obtain Swedish citizenship.

Sweden changed the citizenship law in 1 July 2001 and as of that date Sweden allows dual citizenship.
