Response to Question 10b

I was born in South Africa to Australian parents and obtained South African citizenship at birth. The South African Department of Home Affairs registered my renunciation of South African citizenship on 16 February 2018. I ceased to be a South African citizen on that date.

Pursuant to section 11(1) of the Australian Citizenship Act 1948 I acquired Australian citizenship at the moment of birth by virtue of my birth 'in wedlock' to an Australian citizen mother and father. My birth was registered with the Australian Consulate in Cape Town.

My maternal grandfather was British. However, my mother could not automatically transmit British citizenship to me as British citizenship by descent was strictly patrilineal prior to 1983.


