Response to Attachment to 10b

The only possible pathway to citizenship could be via descent through my parents who were born in the former state of Yugoslavia, in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina. A child may acquire citizenship of Bosnia and Herzegovina by origin, however I understand this was legislated after my parents left Yugoslavia. They also never took up separate citizenship of Bosnia and Herzegovina after its inception. Under the laws of Bosnia and Herzegovina, a child who is born abroad and is eligible for citizenship must be registered by a competent body of Bosnia and Herzegovina by the age of 23. I confirm my parents never sought to register me for foreign citizenship nor have I ever taken any steps to register on my own behalf.
