Attachment to Qualification Checklist question 5b.

At the time of my mother's birth, my mother had no legal father and her mother - my Maternal Grandmother - was solely an Australian citizen.

My Adoptive Maternal Grandfather never took any steps to register my mother as a citizen of Yugoslavia. So even assuming my Adoptive Maternal Grandfather was a citizen of Yugoslavia when he adopted my mother, my mother would not have become a Yugoslavian citizen.

Even if I am wrong and my Adoptive Maternal Grandfather was actually born in a part of the Soviet Union that became Russia, my mother would not have acquired Soviet citizenship because, at the time of her birth, neither of her parents was a Soviet citizen.

My mother never took any steps to acquire Yugoslavian, Soviet or any other foreign citizenship.
