

Section 21 of the Irish Nationality and Citizenship Act 1956, as amended, provides that an Irish citizen of full age who is, or is about to become, a citizen of another country and for that reason desires to renounce their Irish citizenship may do so, if ordinarily resident outside the State, by lodging with the Minister for Justice and Equality a Declaration of Alienage in the prescribed manner and, upon lodgement of the Declaration or, if not then a citizen of that country, upon becoming such, shall cease to be an Irish citizen.

In accordance with the provisions of section 21 of the Act, you ceased to be an Irish citizen with effect from 16th April, 2019, the date of the lodgement of your Declaration of Alienage with the Minister.
