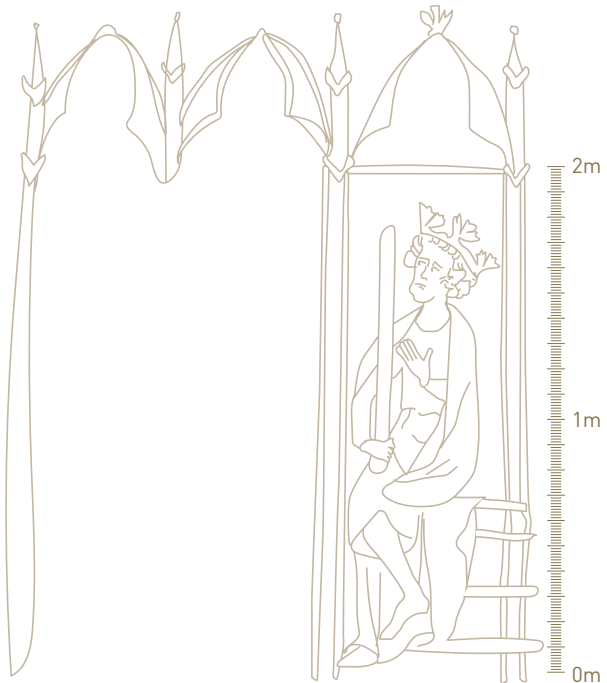
**1 ARE YOU TALLER THAN KING EDWARD 1?**

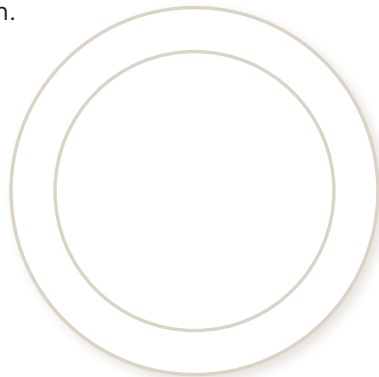
The 1297 Magna Carta was sealed by King Edward I. This is a seal used by the King. Imagine you are the King or Queen.

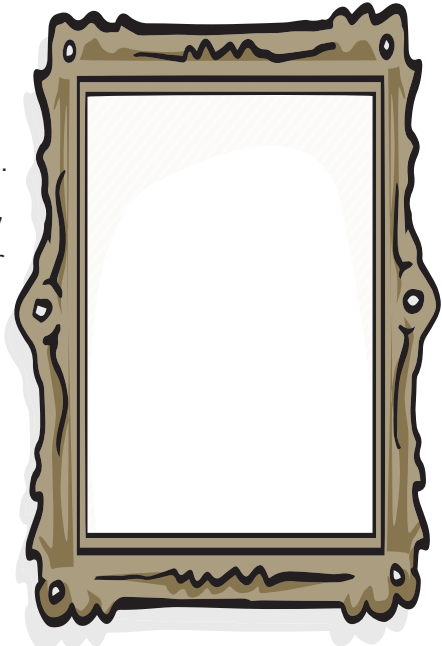

**6 YIRRKALA PETITIONS**

*The thirteen clans came together, negotiated what should be included, and set about preparing this painting which was unique and unprecedented. It could be likened to Magna Carta of Balanda law because it was the first time Yolngu had ever set our law down for others to see.*

**Galarrwuy Yunupingu.**

In 1963, the Yolngu people of Yirrkala sent these petitions to the Australian Parliament requesting their land be returned to them. The petitions feature traditional paintings as well as English and the traditional Gumatji languages.
