

TO THE HONOURABLE THE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES,

PARLIAMENT OF AUSTRALIA, Canberra ACT

This petition of Certain Citizens of Australia draws to the attention of the House:

That the export of historic motor vehicles from Australia continues with no apparent check as required by current legislation enacted for the Protection of Movable Cultural Heritage. The implementation of this Legislation has proved ineffective for some years.

We ask the House of Representatives to consider amending the Protection of Moveable Cultural Heritage Act 1986 relating to antique motor vehicles (items of technological and social significance), in conjunction with the nominated representatives of the Council of Heritage Motor Clubs, the council of Motor Clubs and the Australian Motorlife Museum, with the goal of preserving representative historic motor vehicles in Australia for future generations of Australians.
