

**TO THE HONOURABLE THE SPEAKER AND MEMBERS OF  
THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES**

This petition of certain citizens of Australia

draws to the attention of the House: Australia has been asked to submit its target for its GHG emissions cuts at the UNFCCC meeting in Paris late this year as its share in trying to ensure a global safe climate.

We therefore ask the House to: urgently increase Australia's contribution to international climate action, in line with keeping the global temperature rise to within 1.5 degrees C, beyond which many scientists and countries have said millions of people and other species will face unmanageable suffering and devastation.

We ask that for a start Australia reduces its domestic GHG emissions according to the Climate Change Authority recommendation of 30% below 2000 levels by 2025.
