Note: An additional \$40,195,000 was appropriated to Department of Health (DoH) for the Personal Helpers and Mentors program which will be administered by the Primary Health Networks in conjunction with the Partners in Recovery and Support for Day to Day Living programs totalling \$121,300,000.

An additional \$76 million was appropriated for Australian Disability Enterprises and \$20 million for the demand-driven component of Better Start and Helping Children with Autism programs.
