### Correction to Hansard - Environment and Communications Legislation Committee

Some information provided by **nbn** during the Environment and Communications Legislation Committee spillover hearing on 10 April 2018 needs to be amended.

Please find below an amended excerpt:

**Senator O'NEILL:** I might come back to that in a minute. Mr Ryan, I will go to the specifics of the Redcliffe rollout.

**Mr Ryan:** Redcliffe, yes.

**Senator O'NEILL:** My understanding is that there are 20,000 premises in Redcliffe connecting using Optus HFC infrastructure. Do they run off separate IT and provisioning systems?

**Mr Ryan:** Do you mind if I refer that to Mr McInerney down the end there?

**Mr McInerney:** ~~Yes, at this point in time, they do. They run off the Optus system stack; not the NBN.~~

**Correction:** **The majority of the Optus HFC infrastructure is still managed by Optus systems. Redcliffe has been migrated to nbn and premises are connected using nbn systems.**

**Senator O'NEILL:** Okay. Is that upgradeable in the same way as Telstra HFC? Is it a similar system or is it different?

**Mr McInerney:** In terms of their systems I can't comment, to be perfectly honest. I don't know the Optus platforms and don't get heavily involved in what Optus do in this landscape.

I trust this information will be of assistance to the Committee.
