Dear Senator Fawcett

On 2 March 2020 I appeared as a witness before the Senate Environment and Communications Legislation Committee Estimates Hearing.

During the hearing Senator Waters said in relation to the impacts of climate change on the Reef and climate commitments:

“So who's looking at the global impacts of the trajectory that's been predicted as likely on everybody's climate commitments, including our nation's climate commitments?”

[...]

“Okay, so you are now doing that work in-house—projecting that—“

In response I said

“.....No, it will be with our partners. We will not be doing it. We are coordinating with our partners—our science partners—on this”.

I wish to correct this answer. “[...] We will not be doing it **alone**”. The remainder of my answer to the question, given at the Hearing, is correct.

I apologise for the error in my answer and trust this further information will be of assistance to the Committee.
