Dear Senator Duniam

On 22 October 2018 I appeared as a witness before the Senate Environment and Communications Legislation Committee Estimates Hearing.

During the hearing Senator Hanson-Young said in relation to the Sydney Opera House (page 110 refers):

"Yes, but it would need to be referred to have the logo projected, and using a logo is itself prohibited, isn't it?"

In response I said:

"The conservation management plan which we discussed earlier has provisions in it in relation to the use of the exterior of the Opera House for projection of advertising and so on. So, that is a policy, and it's a policy of the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust."

I wish to correct this answer. I advertently referred to the Sydney Harbour Federation Trust, whereas I was referring to the Sydney Opera House Trust, as is evident from the remainder of my answers to questions in relation to this matter at the Hearing.

I apologise for the error in my answer and trust this further information will be of assistance to the Committee.
