In relation to the below media regarding accessibility of the crediblewomen.com website, the website was "uncategorized" and therefore our content filters then looked at the IP address that was hosting the site. This IP address, used by a Content Distribution Network (CDN), had previously hosted malware which resulted in the "malicious – high risk site" being blocked.

McAfee has advised that the attributes of the site matched patterns commonly associated with malicious sites and our automation engines responded as such. A manual review has been conducted and the website has now been categorised and reclassified to make the site accessible.
