


Senate Standing Committee activity

(Summary as at 14 March 2025)


1. References—comparison at same point of last 3 Parliaments

Select committee activity

(Summary as at 14 March 2025)

The Committee Office supports all Senate select committees and a number of joint select committees.

Select committee activity during the **46**th **Parliament** rose to levels not experienced before, requiring the Committee Office to at one point support 12 select committees concurrently and, over the life of the Parliament, requiring 255 months of support.

In the **47**th **Parliament** to 14 March 2025:


- 14 Senate select committees have been established
- 5 joint select committees have been established 3 supported by the department
- currently there are 2 Senate select committees and 1 joint select committee supported by the department, and
- the department's commitment of secretariat support to select committees is a total of 185 months, with the longest single commitment being 33 months.

The table below compares the number of Senate select and joint select committees supported by the Committee Office across the last five parliaments.

| Parliament | Number of selects (and joint selects) | Average length in months | Total months requiring support |
|--------------------------------------|---------------------------------------|--------------------------|--------------------------------|
| 43 rd | 5 (4) | 10 | 90 |
| 44 th | 12 (2) | 11 | 154 |
| 45 th | 15 (1) | 10 | 160 |
| 46 th | 12 (3) | 17 | 255 |
| 47 th (from commencement) | 14 (3) | 11 | 185 |

In addition, the Committee Office supports four other joint committees.


Senate Select Committee and Joint Committee activity - 47thParliament Activity supported by the Committee Office is as follows.



Staffing

At the end of the 2023-2024 financial year, there was an average of 76.1 full time equivalent (FTE) staff in the Committee Office. The current (12 March 2025) staffing level is 67.4 FTE, with the year-to-date average being 71.4 FTE. The following chart shows changes in average staffing levels over time.

Administration

The current (2024-25) annual budget for the Committee Office is approximately \$10.8 million. This includes employee expenses of \$10.6 million and administrative expenses of \$0.2 million. So far in the 2024-25 financial year (as at 28 February 2025), the Committee Office actual expenditure is \$7.1 million.
