Clarification to Hansard

I write to you concerning evidence provided to the Senate Standing Committee on Legal and Constitutional Affairs during the Senate Estimates hearing on Tuesday, 3 March 2020.

Our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Social Justice Commissioner, Ms June Oscar AO, would like to correct a detail:

On page 78 of the transcript, in her first exchange with Senator Siewert, Commissioner Oscar stated that:

Ms Oscar: Wiyi Yani U Thangani—women's voices, in my Bunuba language. The report will be tabled at the end of this month or transmitted to the national Indigenous affairs department.

I would like to clarify that the tabling date of the report is yet to be set, and the report is due for transmission to the Attorney-General's Office by 27 March 2020.
