


# CPAC chronology

Date	Action
S22(1)(a)(ii)	
8 August 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AGD (Sarah Chidgey) wrote to the Hon Tony Abbott S47F(1)</li> </ul>
9 August 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>CPAC starts.</li> <li>AGD left voicemail message for Mr Cooper on 9 August to seek confirmation that our emails had been received.</li> <li>AGO requested that we call Mr Abbott's Office.</li> </ul>

30 August 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AGD received a call from Mr Abbott's office at around 1400 - discussed Mr Abbott's obligations and were assured that a registration with respect to CPAC would be completed when Mr Abbott returned from overseas the following week.</li> <li>S22(1)(a)(ii)</li> </ul>
2 September 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Secretary's meeting with the AG - Noted contact from Mr Abbott's office that Mr Abbott would be completing a registration shortly. Also noted S22(1)(a)(ii)</li> <li>S22(1)(a)(ii)</li> </ul>
27 September 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>AGD followed up with Mr Abbott's office but did not receive a return call.</li> </ul>
15 October 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>S45 to Mr Cooper almost finalised; Having received no registration from Mr Abbott, AGD sent an email at 14:04 to remind him that he had undertaken to register, and to draw his attention to another potentially registrable activity he had undertaken in Hungary.</li> </ul>
22 October 2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>S45 notice sent to Mr Cooper by email at 09:52.</li> </ul>

- Follow-up call – message left on voicemail.
- To date, no response has been received.
- At approximately 14:40 AGD received a call from <sup>S22(1)(a)(ii)</sup> of Mr Abbott's office, who advised that Mr Abbott had received an email that day from Mr Cooper, stating that CPAC was 100% organised by LibertyWorks, that there was no input from or relationship with the ACU, and that the ACU had not provided any funding.
- AGD confirmed that Mr Abbott could hold off registering in relation to CPAC until the s45 was resolved, but encouraged him to complete his other registration obligations in the meantime.


- 2 August 2019:

S42(1) and outlined our actions to date, including sending letters to LiberthWorks, seeking confirmation from LibertyWorks on 7 August that the correspondence had been received, and that letters had been sent to relevant speakers (Abbott, S47F(1)).
  - Email from Tim Wellington to AGD asking whether AGD had contacted the office of Mr Abbott and suggesting we call him beforehand to let him know about the letter.
