

As reported in the *Daily Telegraph* on 12 September 2024, Sheik Ibrahim Dadoun of the UMA celebrated the October 7 attacks at a rally in Lakemba, and the UMA has been linked to the extremist group Hizb ut-Tahrir.

In a media release published by Julian Hill MP, assistant minister for multicultural affairs and citizenship, the UMAC was specifically invited to apply for a social cohesion grant.

Despite his comments, last month assistant minister for multiculturalism Julian Hill specifically invited United Muslims Australia, along with two other Muslim groups, to apply for the grants.

A media release issued by Hill's office at the time said that "empowering young Australian Muslims locally is critical to building connections and tackling division, prejudice and hate."

The United Muslims of Australia website lists Dadoun as one of the organisation's sheiks and promoted as a speaker.

Along with celebrating October 7, Dadoun has also been present at a number of events organised by the group.



In October 2024, the IDF released drone footage of Sinwar's final moments before his death, where he throws an object at the drone before he is killed. The line on this post which says 'defiant till his very last breath' appears to be referring to this.



The AMWCHR's Linktree website promotes a call script, 'Payphones for Palestine', which encourages its supporters to call their local senators and MPs and demand the Australian Government "End all support for Israel", including by "cutting off economic, industry, trade, diplomatic and military relationships, cooperation schemes, investments and programs". This is clearly advocating for the anti-Israel Boycotts, Divestments and Sanctions movement.

The AMWCHR's Linktree website also encourages supporters to donate to UNRWA, despite UNRWA being embroiled in allegations that several of its employees may have been involved in Hamas' October 7 attacks. Israel has passed a law banning UNRWA from operating in Israeli territory.

Key demands for an unscripted call

- Sanction Israeli officials: impose targeted sanctions on individuals and entities involved in Israel's genocide, occupation and apartheid regime.
- End all support for Israel: this includes cutting off economic, industry, trade, diplomatic and military relationships, cooperation schemes, investments and programs.
- Cut off the weapons: suspend all arms agreements, cooperation and deals with Israel, including the export, import and transfer of arms, parts, components and dual use items used by Israel in its assaults on the Palestinian people.
- Stop Australians funding the occupation: cancel the DGR status of any Australian charities that contribute to, support or benefit from Israel's illegal settlements.
- Hold Israel accountable: proactively support investigations into Israeli war crimes and cooperate with the International Court of Justice and International Criminal Court.
- Respect Palestinian rights: uphold international law and recognise the rights of the Palestinian people to self-determination.

Payphones for Palestine acknowledge Dja Dja Wurrung, Wurudjeri and Bunurong People as the Traditional Owners of the lands on which we live, work and organise. We pay our respects to their Elders past and present and recognise that the ongoing land theft, occupation and genocide in Palestine is connected to First Nations struggles here and across the globe.



Yesterday, Senator Fatima Payman was indefinitely suspended from the caucus by Prime Minister Anthony Albanese for voting with her conscience against genocide. Her stance was a commitment to justice and the right thing to do.

We fully support Senator Payman's courageous stance in exercising her right to vote according to her conscience, representing the views of millions of fellow Australians.

The reprimand and targeting of Senator Fatima Payman by the Prime Minister is a desperate attempt to save face for failing to decisively speak against genocide and the killing of more than 40,000 Palestinians.

Political calculations and attempts to walk both sides have devastating consequences in Palestine and will ultimately end in failure.

Australians and millions across the world demand decisive action in the form of sanctions and an immediate stop to weapons trade and training. Australia is currently undertaking war games with the United States and Israel. Australia also just removed checks on defence exports to the USA and the UK, which both are key weapons suppliers to Israel.

The dreams and hopes of Palestinians are not any losser than ours and those of our children.

A vote in the Senate to recognise Palestine as a state would have sent a strong message internationally and domestically.
