The Division was asked a question about what new funding was given by the Commonwealth for the Launceston City Deal. The response appears in the Proof Committee Hansard as follows:

I write to provide the following factual corrections:

- The Commonwealth's funding contributions to the Launceston City Deal comprise a total of \$147.83 million (not \$149.33 million as answered).
- The Commonwealth's contribution included \$1.5 million for the Tamar Estuary work (not \$2 million as answered).

I would appreciate if you could please note this for the information of the Committee. I apologise for any confusion this may have caused.
