- Corporate Matters: a detailed summary of the Agriculture budget including the allocation of funding across all programs, measures, national action plans, national strategic action plans, national strategies, roadmaps, announcements made by the Minister and grants as well as an outline of the funding as expended, committed, or unallocated including a breakdown by state and territory.
- Outcome 3: Agriculture Workforce Shortage information pertaining to the Pacific Australian Labour Mobility program and other workforce measures.
- Outcome 3: A detailed summary of the funding already announced across Agriculture Policy.
- Outcome 4: A detailed summary of the funding allocated to biosecurity programs, measures and grants including an outline of expended, committed, or unallocated funds including a breakdown by state and territory. In addition, detailed information relating to the funding that is included in the 2022-23 Budget for those measures already announced by the Government.

I trust that you will be able to table all the requested information at the start of the hearing. Please contact my office if this will not be possible, or if you require clarification on any of these requests.

I look forward to seeing you at the hearing.
