Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Legal and Constitutional Affairs Legislation Committee estimates hearing.

The committee met from 9.00am until 11.07pm.

The committee called:

- Australian Federal Police (AFP);
- Australian Criminal Intelligence Commission and the Australian Institute of Criminology;
- Australian Transaction Reports and Analysis Centre (AUSTRAC);
- Australian Security Intelligence Organisation; and
- Department of Home Affairs, examining cross-portfolio, corporate and general matters and Outcome 1.

Topics discussed by the committee included:

- AFP's investigation of the Minister Taylor/Lord Mayor Clover Moore events;
- AUSTRAC's investigation of breaches by Westpac;
- foreign interference;
- right wing extremism; and
- changes in regional aviation security.

The committee will next meet at 9.00am on Tuesday 3 March 2020 in the Main Committee Room calling:

- department and agencies in the Attorney-General's Portfolio, including Attorney-General's Department, Australian Human Rights Commission, Federal Court of Australia, Family Court of Australia and Federal Circuit Court of Australia; Administrative Appeals Tribunal, Office of the Australian Information Commissioner, High Court of Australia, Independent National Security Legislation Monitor, Australian Commission for Law Enforcement Integrity, and National Archives of Australia.
