

Senate Rural and Regional Affairs and Transport Legislation Committee Supplementary Budget Estimates 2019-20 Tuesday, 22 October 2019 Daily summary

Here is the summary of today's proceedings in the Rural and Regional Affairs and Transport Legislation Committee estimates hearing.

The committee met from 9.03am until 10.07pm.

The committee called the Department of Agriculture, Dairy Australia Limited, Australian Livestock Export Corporation Limited (LiveCorp), Australian Pork Limited, Fisheries Research and Development Corporation and the Regional Investment Corporation.

Topics discussed by the committee included:

- Dog deployments at various north Australian airports;
- Dairy Australia Levy payments;
- feral pig population management;
- LiveCorp dehumidification trials;
- state of Australian fish stocks and fisheries management;
- water usage for almond plantations in the Riverina;
- intergovernmental cooperation to ensure animal welfare; and
- risks associated with live animal exports.
