Name of bill:

Social Services Legislation Amendment (Drug Testing Trial) Bill 2018

Reasons for referral/principal issues for consideration:

- This Bill reintroduces a 2017-18 Budget measure to establish a two year trial of drug testing for 5,000 recipients of Newstart Allowance and Youth Allowance (other) in three locations. The Bill was subject to a Senate Inquiry which reported on 6 September 2017.
- However, this Bill now names the three locations the Canterbury-Bankstown, New South Wales; Logan, Queensland: and Mandurah, Western Australia, regions.
  - Not named in the previous Bill.
- It is important that people, organisations and the local government authorities in the named locations are able to have a proper say of the possible impacts of the trial and the readiness of the regions in terms of alcohol and drug rehabilitation services and providers.

- People in the named regions likely to be impacted by the trial.
- Local government authorities likely to be impacted by the trial.
- Alcohol and other drug rehabilitation organisation and other support services in the named regions likely to be impacted by the trial.
