Questions Taken on Notice at ECONOMICS REFERENCES COMMITTEE Non-conforming building products on Thursday, 2 August 2018.

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Question:

CHAIR: Can you provide to us on notice, if necessary, a list of what you have referred to in the past as the 2016 projects, which are the projects that are subject to the 2016 building code? Ms Cato: Yes, Senator.

CHAIR: Is that an extensive list?

Ms Cato: It's a rolling stock list. It's a group of products that changes. I'd like to explain to the committee that the code has application in quite a complicated way. It attaches to contractors rather than to projects, and then the date that they've tendered for the particular project impacts on whether or not the code applies on a particular project. With respect to the requirements relating to Australian standard building materials, they apply on a much more limited number of projects, which is those that, firstly, have Commonwealth funding attached to them. At the moment, there are 164 of those that are directly procured by Commonwealth funding entities. It also has some application to Commonwealth funded building work that is procured by the states and territories, where it is indirectly funded by the Commonwealth.

CHAIR: So you're able to identify those projects by virtue of—Ms Cato: Yes. We can provide you with a list of the 146 projects.

Written questions for the ABCC.

Questions

1. In reference to the following question from Senator Cameron on Wednesday 28th February 2018 at Senate Estimates (page 180) and response:

"Senator Cameron: Would noncompliance with the terms of the contract be considered a breach of the code by the ABCC?

Ms Cato: The code itself—the law that we are monitoring—doesn't set it up as a breach of the code. If the contractor is not complying with the terms of their contract with the funding entity, that is a matter for the funding entity to deal with. If we found out that they weren't, we would refer that to the funding entity so that they could then take appropriate steps."

- a) How many referrals have you made to funding entities of this nature and what would you consider being appropriate steps for them to take?
 Response: The ABCC has made one referral to a funding entity. The steps taken in response to the referral are a matter for the funding entity. A funding entity may consider the requirements of paragraphs 10.10 and 10.37 of the Commonwealth Procurement Rules (CPR), which since 1 March 2017, contain requirements relating to goods and services meeting applicable Australian standards.
- b) How many referrals have you made to the Federal Safety Commissioner about this issue or any other issue, such as a health and safety issues?
 Response: The ABCC has made no referrals.
- c) Given the requirements in the Commonwealth Procurement rules, specifically 10.10 and 10.38 as set out by Ms Cato in evidence at the recent hearing, how many referrals has the ABCC made to the Department of Finance about non-compliance with Australian Standards?

Response: The ABCC has made no referrals.

d) Is this a course of action that the ABCC is intending to use at some point? If so, what criteria need to be met for this to occur?

Response: In the event that the ABCC identifies that a funding entity has not complied with the requirements of the *Code for the Tendering and Performance of Building Work 2016* (the Code), the ABC Commissioner will consider the circumstances and if appropriate refer the matter to the Department of Finance.

The criteria is set out in the funding entity compliance process published on the ABCC's website: https://www.abcc.gov.au/building-code/building-code-resources/funding-entity-resources.

e) The ABCC's quarterly report of the Second Quarter of 2016-17, which was its first quarterly report states:

"Under section 38(ca) of the BCIIP Act, the Federal Safety Commissioner has the function of auditing compliance with National Construction Code performance requirements in relation to building materials. During the reporting period, the Australian Building and Construction Commissioner wrote to the Federal Safety Commissioner requesting a meeting about these new requirements. A meeting is scheduled to discuss how the responsibilities of each Office can be discharged to their fullest extent, in the most efficient manner possible."

Can the ABCC please provide this correspondence and the result of the meeting? In addition, can the ABCC also outline how responsibilities under the Act and Code between the ABCC and the FSC have been divided and managed?

Response: On 22 December 2016, the former ABC Commissioner wrote to the former Federal Safety Commissioner (FSC), Mr Alan Edwards. A copy of this letter is at **Attachment A**.

On 10 February 2017 Mr Edwards and his staff met with representatives of the ABCC, including the former National Manager Building Code, Ms Cathy Cato. It was agreed that there was no overlap between the legislative requirements within the ABC Commissioner's jurisdiction and the Federal Safety Commissioner's jurisdiction.

Responsibilities under the Act and the Code are implemented by the Commissioner responsible for the legislative function. The ABC Commissioner's legislative function relating to building materials is to ensure that funding entities procuring building work impose Code requirements that relate to the use of Australian standard building products.

The Federal Safety Commissioner's legislative function relating to building materials is to audit compliance with National Construction Code (NCC) performance requirements. The NCC does not require the use of Australian standard products. Rather, the NCC addresses the fitness for purpose of materials in the context of the structural integrity of the finished building.

- f) Section 20 of the BCIIP Act deals with the information in Quarterly and Annual reports which must be made by the agency. At clause (2)(i) it states that information to be included is (i) details of activities that the ABC Commissioner has undertaken during that quarter or year to monitor the compliance of products used in building work with relevant Australian standards published by, or on behalf of, Standards Australia;
- This suggests that it is the ABCC's role to monitor compliance of products used in building work?
- Do you consider that it is part of the ABCC's role to monitor the compliance of products used in building work with the relevant Australian Standards?

- o If so, how do you do it?
- If so, why have you not included this activity in Quarterly and Annual Reports?

Response: The ABCC's role in monitoring the compliance of products used in building work with the relevant Australian Standards is limited by the requirements in the legislation.

The Code imposes requirements on funding entities and the ABCC monitors the compliance of funding entities with these requirements. The ABCC also audits supply chain contracts to assess whether the model clauses used by funding entities to comply with these requirements are effective. Issues identified would be referred to the funding entities as a potential breach of contract. The ABCC's monitoring role is included in its BCIIP Quarterly and Annual Reports.

New Compliance Requirements for Commonwealth-funded Building Work

I write in relation to the recently enacted *Building and Construction Industry (Improving Productivity) Act* 2016 (the Act) and *Code for the Tendering and Performance of Building Work* 2016 (the Code), and specifically the new functions required of both our Offices for which there is overlap.

The Building Code 2016 for which I am responsible, requires funding entities to only contract for building work with code covered entities who only use products in building work that comply with the relevant Australian Standards. Beyond this, I have a general responsibility under the Act to investigate suspected contraventions, by building industry participants, of the Act, designated building laws and the Code.

I note the requirement conferred on you for auditing compliance with National Construction Code performance requirements in relation to building materials.

I believe this is an area where we can work together to ensure the responsibilities of our Offices are discharged to their fullest extent, in the most efficient manner possible.

To that end, I request a meeting in the New Year to discuss these matters.
