Mr Moore: I would have to check. I think it was around August

Question on Notice No. 7 - Discussions with Mr Shearer from PMO

Senator Conroy asked on 22 July 2014, Hansard page 53:

Senator CONROY: So you would have had discussions with Mr Shearer—by definition, that is what the trip was about.

Rear Adm. Sammut: Mr Shearer was involved in discussions, but we have not been discussing the program directly with Mr Shearer.

Senator CONROY: Mr Shearer has not had any discussions with you or anyone in your bid team?

Rear Adm. Sammut: Are we talking about the CEP process?

Senator CONROY: Yes. **Rear Adm. Sammut:** No.

Senator CONROY: Has he had any discussions with Mr Moore or Mr Dewar? It is harder for you to identify whether he has been having conversations with Mr Baxter. Has he been having any conversations directly with either of you two?

Mr Dewar: No, he has not with me.

Mr Moore: No.

Senator CONROY: Are you aware if he has been having discussions with Mr

Baxter?

Mr Dewar: I would need to look into that. I just do not know.

Senator CONROY: If you could take on notice whether or not Mr Shearer from the

Prime Minister's office has been contacting Mr Baxter about this process.

Mr Dewar: Sure.

Response:

Yes. In his role as Deputy Secretary Strategy, Mr Baxter is responsible for coordinating the Defence White Paper and jointly overseeing the Force Structure Review and periodically discusses a range of defence issues with the Prime Minister's Office.
