The Northern Endeavour is positioned closer to East Timor and Indonesia than the Australian coast, and considerable concerns remain there about Australian oil and gas operations after the impact of the Montara oil spill. Are there ongoing discussions with the governments of East Timor or Indonesia about this Bill or other aspects of the Australian oil and gas industry?

**ANSWER**

There are no ongoing discussions with the governments of Timor-Leste or Indonesia regarding the Bill.

There are ongoing discussions between Australia and Timor-Leste about areas of shared responsibility for oil and gas in the Timor Sea. These discussions primarily relate to progressing arrangements for the Greater Sunrise Special Regime established under the *Treaty Between Australia and the Democratic Republic of Timor-Leste Establishing Their Maritime Boundaries in the Timor Sea (the Maritime Boundary Treaty)*.
